MESSAGE Installation

- Current version dates from April 2011
- Can be installed on Windows XP/Vista/7
- Installation procedure is similar to any other software
- To install and use the model user should have right to create/modify folders
- By default the model is installed into “Programs/MESSAGE_Int” directory
 - Destination can be changed

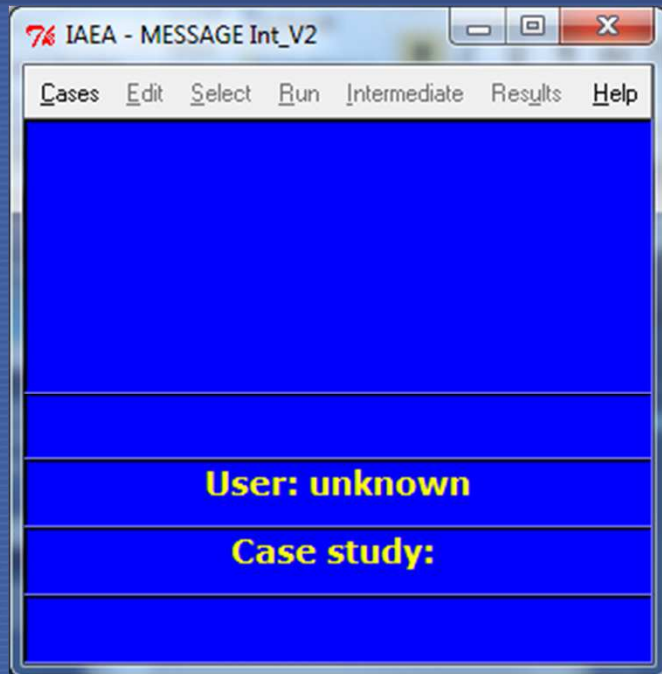
Attention!

- If there is a version of MESSAGE already installed on the computer it is possible to install/update software only or to reinstall it (IN THE LATER CASE MODEL DATA DEVELOPPED IN AN EARLIER VERSION WILL BE LOST)
- It is recommended to save/backup all model data before reinstallation

Installed Components

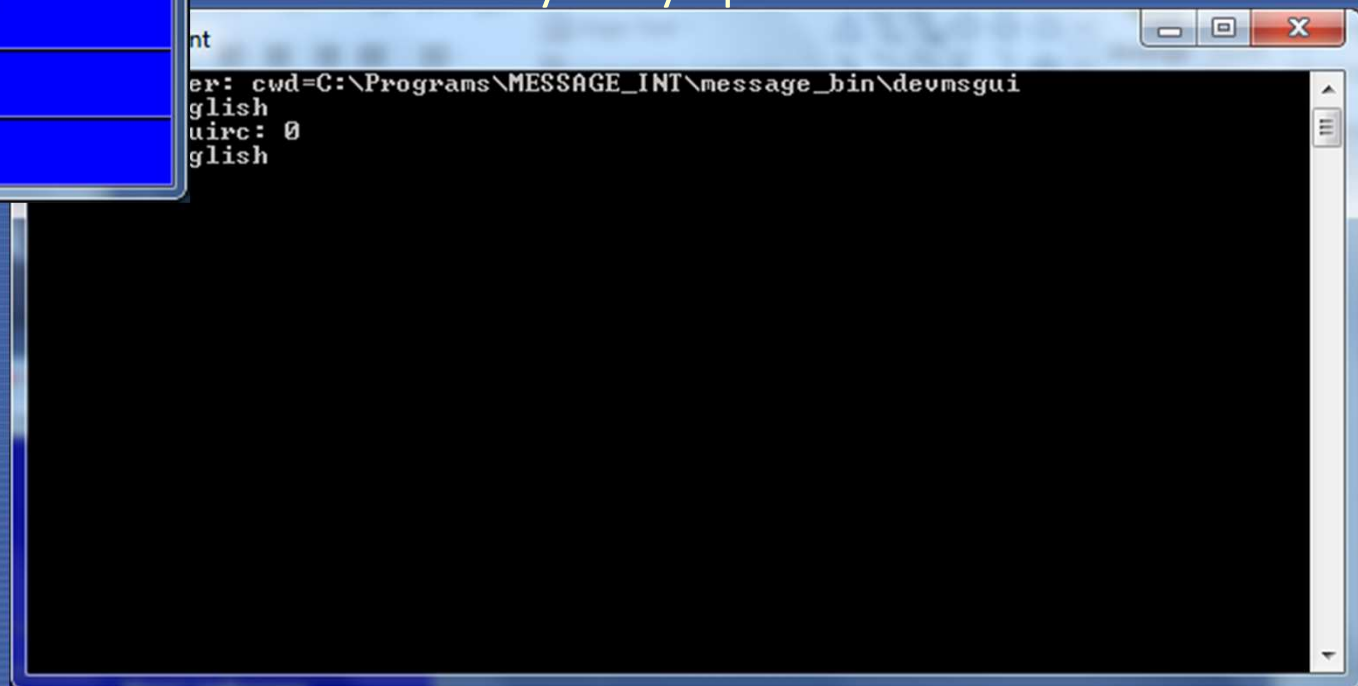
- MESSAGE user interface
 - Available in English, French, Spanish and Russian
- Matrix generator
- Free solver (glpk)
 - Support for commercial solver cplex is in-build, but the license must be procured separately – IAEA can support member countries in license acquisition
- Demonstration Cases (Demo cases)
- User manual (English)

After Installation - Start



- “Blue” Screen to operate the model

- “Black” Screen to view model messages (log)
- Must always stay open



Main Model Operations

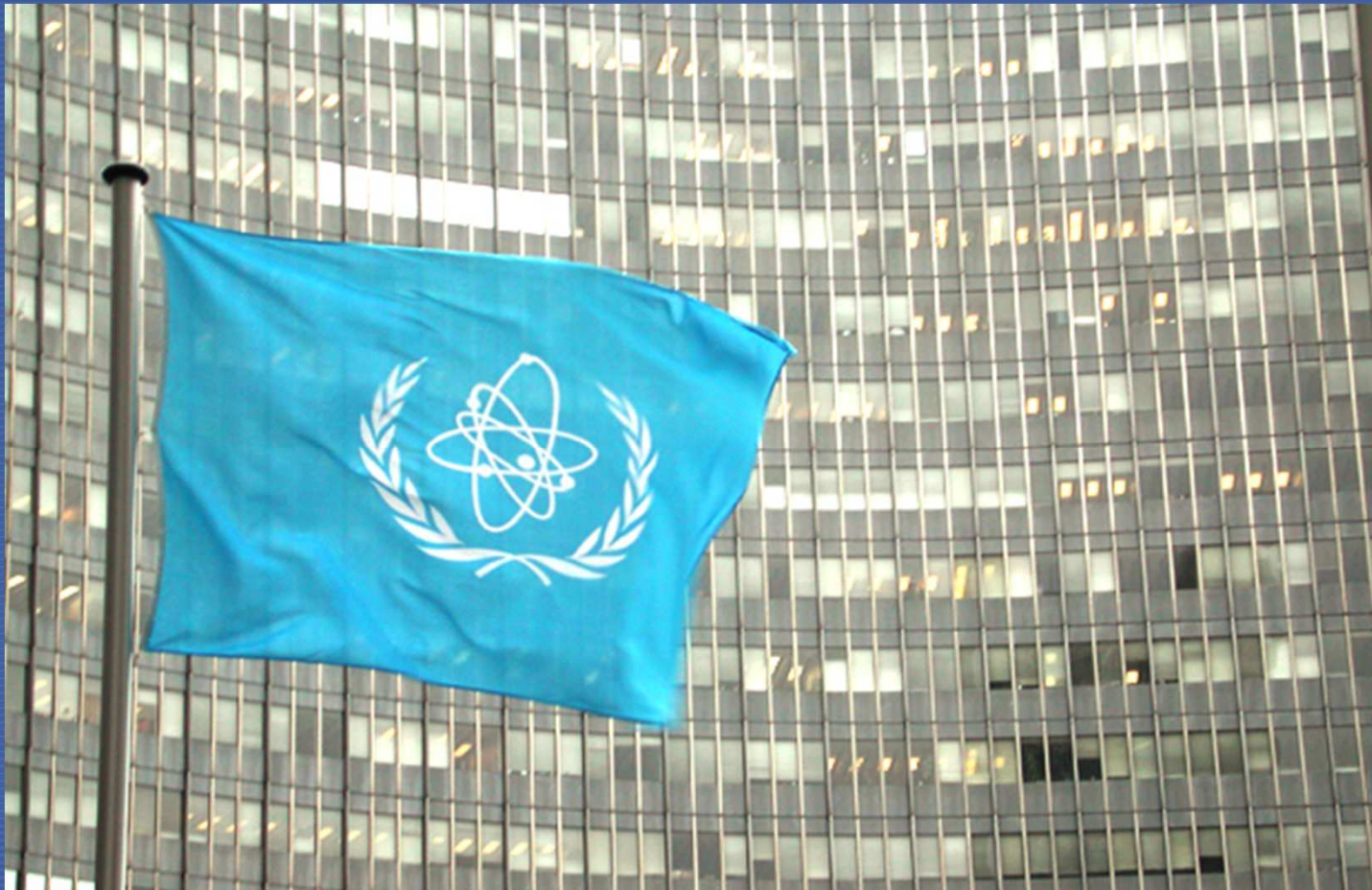
- Create

- Package is not to be sold or used to provide services for a fee
- Package is not to be released to another State or International Organization without the advance written approval of IAEA
