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
## Introduction of Energy and Climate Objectives in SEE

- National Energy and Climate Plans (NECPs) are a new framework for EU member states to plan climate and energy objectives, targets, policies and measures in an integrated manner.
- ☐ Similar to EU Members States, Contracting Parties of the Energy Community are also committed to develop NECPs.
- Energy Community (EnC) Contracting Parties have therefore taken its responsibility to develop a National Energy and Climate Plan (NECP) in line with EnC's Council of Ministers 2018/1 / MC-EnC Recommendation:
  - Creation of analytical, institutional and regulatory preconditions for the development of NECP
  - Establishment of the National Working Group for the Development of NECP
    - ➤ The first NECP draft should be submitted to EnC by the beginning of 2020!








## **NECP Development CHALLENGES!**

- Establishment of a functional coordination mechanism (a large number of stakeholders)

- 4. Creation of a national legal framework for NECP and WG


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
