NOTIFICATION by the Director-General of IRENA

Thirteenth session of the IRENA Assembly and related meetings 14–15 January 2023 St. Regis Hotel, Saadiyat Island, Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates

The thirteenth session of the Assembly of the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA) will be held in-person from 14 to 15 January 2023 in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates, under the theme 'World Energy Transition – The Global Stocktake'.

Marking the 3rd World Energy Transition Day, the Assembly will commence its work on Saturday, 14 January 2023, with the Official Opening at 10.00 AM, followed by a High-level Plenary session on World Energy Transition – The Global Stocktake.

A number of strategic, administrative and institutional matters will be considered in the context of the Assembly session. Additionally, a series of Ministerial and High-Level meetings, as well as thematic and stakeholder meetings, will be held over the course of the Assembly, including on Friday, 13 January 2023, the day preceding the opening of the Assembly.

Ministerial and High-Level Meetings

During the Assembly session and Pre-Assembly Day, the following Ministerial and High-Level meetings will be convened:

- o The Ministerial meeting on 'Climate Pledges to Action: Amplifying Energy Transition for Sustainable Development in SIDS' will be held on Friday, 13 January from 14.00 to 16.00.
- O The High-Level meeting on 'Energy Compact on Renewable Energy for the United Nations Peacekeeping' will be held on Friday, 13 January from 16.00 to 18.00.
- O The Ministerial Roundtable on 'Decarbonising Shipping: The role of ports in addressing supply, demand and trade of renewable-based fuels' will be held on Saturday, 14 January from 16.15 to 18.15.
- The Ministerial Dialogue on 'Regional Energy Transition Outlooks: Southeast Asia Energy Transitions' will be held on Sunday, 15 January from 10.00 to 11.30.
- The Ministerial Dialogue on 'Critical materials for the Renewables-Centred Energy Transition: How to jointly harness opportunities' will be held on Sunday, 15 January from 11.30 to 13.00.
- The Ministerial Dialogue on 'Energy Transition Accelerator Financing (ETAF) Platform' will be held on Sunday, 15 January from 14.30 to 16.00.

Plenary sessions

As the supreme decision-making organ of IRENA, the Assembly will consider and discuss a number of programmatic and institutional matters relevant to the Agency's future work and direction. Members will also consider a number of administrative and institutional matters.

A. Strategic and Programmatic items

Members will have the opportunity to exchange experiences and best practices on national and global efforts towards a just and resilient energy future, and to provide guidance to the Agency's programmatic activities in this regard. Over the course of the Assembly, these sessions will cover the following items:

- o Annual Report of the Director-General on the Implementation of the Work Programme and Budget for 2022-2023, as well as the Draft Medium-Term Strategy 2023-2027
- o Member Interventions
- o Administrative and Institutional matters and other mandates

Delegations wishing to make an intervention under the Annual Report, Draft Medium-Term Strategy and/or the role of energy transitions in the context of the Global Stocktake, are invited to **register in the Speakers List** by sending a request noting the name and title of the speaker to Assembly@irena.org, indicating in the subject line "IRENA Assembly: Speakers List". The requests will be considered observing the international protocol precedence and the principle of "first come, first served".

A preliminary Speakers List based on requests received will be circulated prior to the opening session of the Assembly.

Delegations are also invited to submit written statements to the Secretariat in advance of delivery. Full official written statements will be made available to the Membership and included as part of the official records of the session.

In the interest of enhancing transparency and inclusiveness, open sessions and meetings of the Assembly will be live streamed on the IRENA website.

B. Elections and appointments

The designations of India as President, and Belgium, Indonesia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, and Zimbabwe as Vice-Presidents of the thirteenth session of the Assembly, are expected to be officially confirmed at the start of the Plenary session of the Assembly (item 2.a. of the Provisional Agenda).
